### **PCACA President's Report**

#### Washington D.C. Trip

Elaine Wong and members of the National CACA Advocacy team met with U.S. Congresswoman Krysten Sinema in Washington D.C. over the summer. This year's meeting with Congressional members focused on the following:

Preservation of Cultural and Historical Sites through the Travel Promotion Act of 2009; Immigration Reform: Harnessing the Potential of Immigration; and upgrade Major Kurt Chew-Een Lee's Silver Star to the Medal of Honor for heroism and

leadership at the Battle of Chosin Reservoir during the Korean War.

#### **Immigration Reform Update**

It appears that immigration reform is officially dead for this Congress. It is disappointing that the House failed despite the unprecedented advocacy and activity from organizations like CACA who were not excited about the Senate bill (s.744) because of its flaws. We also believe Congress is not likely to tackle immigration reform until after the next national election in 2017. Following the June 30 announcement that House Speaker John Boehner could not get immigration reform done, President Obama said he would do what he could within his legal authority to address our broken immigration system. He asked the Department of Homeland Security and Department of Justice to present options by year end. Even though legislative reform will not happen this year, we must continue to educate Congress, the media, and our own community on these pressing issues.

# **PCACA Celebrates 40th Anniversary**
